

Code of Conduct for Visitors to the FC Slovan Liberec Premises

§1

General Provisions

- 1.** This Code of Conduct for Visitors /CCfV/ is a regulation issued by FC Slovan Liberec, a. s., with the registered office at Na Hradbách 1300, Liberec, and defines fundamental binding rules of conduct for all visitors to FC Slovan Liberec who are entering the FC Slovan Liberec premises and using any equipment of FC Slovan Liberec.
- 2.** Purpose of this CCfV is especially to secure protection of safety of health and property at the stadium as well as to ensure, as much as possible, ideal conditions for the course of all actions that will take place at the stadium. Purpose of this FC Slovan Liberec CCfV is also to ensure a pleasant sporty and social atmosphere at the stadium. By each entering by you to any event held by the FC Slovan Liberec you express your consent with being bound by the terms and conditions and contents of this CCfV.

§2

FC Slovan Liberec

- 1.** The FC Slovan Liberec premises serve preferably to the public for watching football matches and it is exclusively the company FC Slovan Liberec, a.s. that decides on the manner of its utilization and use.
- 2.** Public may enter the FC Slovan Liberec premises only with an approval of the FC Slovan Liberec, only in times specified by this CCfV or, in exceptional cases, by another decision and only in compliance with the terms and conditions given by this CCfV.
- 3.** This CCfV is binding on all persons who will use the FC Slovan Liberec for their own events on the basis of a special contract concluded for a specific purpose with the FC Slovan Liberec as well as binding on guests of these persons.
- 4.** Besides FC Slovan Liberec, a.s. also any organising service, security service or, as the case may be, the Police of the Czech Republic within the framework of their legal powers are entitled to supervise the following and respecting of this CCfV.

§3

Stay at the FC Slovan Liberec

- 1.** Only persons who have a valid entrance ticket or another document authorizing them or any persons who may demonstrate their right of stay in another way may be staying inside the FC Slovan Liberec premises. Each person inside the FC Slovan Liberec premises has the duty to prove, at request of the organising or security personnel as well as upon request of the police, its entitlement to stay with a valid entrance ticket or another authorizing document. Everyone who is not able to prove his/her entitlement to stay will be escorted out of the FC Slovan Liberec premises. Upon leaving the FC Slovan Liberec premises the entrance ticket loses its validity; this also applies to holders of permanent entrance tickets entitled to enter on a particular day.
- 2.** The FC Slovan Liberec premises are always open to public at least one hour before commencement of an event up to one hour following the end of such event unless organisational reasons provide for otherwise.
- 3.** Visitors are obligated to occupy only the seat specified on their entrance tickets for the given event. Fans and supporters of the guest team are obligated to stay only in the sector provided by the FC Slovan Liberec for supporters of a guest team and are obligated to respect organisational instructions of the organising or security personnel or, as the case may be, of the Police of the CR.

4. Due to security reasons and for the purpose of averting a danger visitors are obligated to take other seats or, as the case may be, occupy another sector than specified on their entrance tickets based on instructions issued by organising and security personnel as well as by the police. The same will apply to the visitors who come after an event that has already started.

5. Persons who are apparently under influence of alcohol or other drugs forming habit as well as any persons who are threatening the safety of other persons and property located in the FC Slovan Liberec premises shall lose their entitlement to stay and may be escorted by the organising or security personnel or, as the case may be, by the Police of the CR from the premises at any time.

§4

Entry Check

1. When entering the FC Slovan Liberec premises, each visitor is obligated to show without request and submit his/her entrance ticket or another authorizing card upon request to be checked by the organising or security personnel.

2. Organising personnel or security personnel as well as the police are entitled to examine, even with the use of any technical aids, persons who may represent a safety risk for the given event because of suspicion of previous consumption of alcohol or other drugs forming habit or because of bringing in any weapons or other dangerous items or things or substances that cause the danger of fire. The examination also applies to brought-in luggage and enables an examination of individual items brought-in.

3. It is prohibited to bring in to the FC Slovan Liberec premises any objects that put safety and the relevant facilities of persons and property located in the FC Slovan Liberec premises in danger. It is the organising or security personnel or, as the case may be in individual and exceptional cases, the police pursuant to the Act No. 274/2008 Sb. who may decide on the prohibition to bring such objects in the FC Slovan Liberec premises.

4. The persons who cannot prove their authorization to visit or enter the FC Slovan Liberec premises or the persons who are representing a security risk within the purpose of this CCfV will not be allowed to enter the FC Slovan Liberec premises. The same will apply to the persons who have been prohibited to enter the organised event in the Czech Republic due to their objectionable behaviour at similar events. Such rejected persons are not entitled to a refund of their entry fee.

5. Organising personnel are entitled to request a visitor to prove his/her identity upon entering the premises and use the data obtained in this way in any cases of breaching the CCfV.

§ 5

Behaviour inside the FC Slovan

Liberec Premises

1. Each visitor to the FC Slovan Liberec premises is obligated to behave inside the premises of the football stadium so that he/she cannot endanger safety of other people and their property as well as any facilities of the FC Slovan Liberec. Further, a visitor must not restrict or bother other people above the extent corresponding to the circumstances that result from the course of the event currently running in the FC Slovan Liberec premises.

2. Visitors are obligated to follow any orders and instructions of the organising or security personnel as well of the police, fire brigade, ambulance personnel and the announcer.

3. During their stay at the stadium visitors to the FC Slovan Liberec premises are obligated to respect any generally binding rules of polite behaviour and good manners, i.e. especially, politeness and respectfulness, and are obligated to refrain from any demonstrations of interpersonal, racial, religious or political hatred. In case of breaching or disrespecting this provision

a visitor who is committing an apparently prohibited conduct may be escorted immediately out of the FC Slovan Liberec premises without any previous warning.

4. It is an obligation to keep all entrances as well as all exits and emergency exits free of obstacles.

§6

Prohibitions

1. Visitors to the stadium are prohibited to bring especially the below mentioned items or any other items of similar nature or purpose in the FC Slovan Liberec premises:

- a)** any racial, defamatory, vulgar or conflicting-with-good-manners propaganda material;
- b)** weapons of any kind as well as any items that can be used as chopping, banging or stabbing weapons;
- c)** sprays and caustic, flammable and colouring substances or any other vessels filled with a substance harmful to people's life;
- d)** any bottles, cups/goblets, jugs, cans/tins or any other items that are made of breakable, splintering or extra hard materials;
- e)** any unfoldable items such as a ladder, stool, chair, box or a suitcase;
- f)** fireworks/Roman candles, signal rockets, smoke bombs and other pyrotechnical items including any relevant launching technique;
- g)** any flag poles or banners;
- h)** mechanically-driven tools that make noise;
- i)** alcoholic drinks or drugs of any kind;
- j)** animals;
- k)** laser pointers;
- l)** suitcases, big bags, rucksacks; or
- m)** cameras, video cameras and any other devices used for professional recording of voice or picture, except in cases expressly approved by the FC Slovan Liberec.

2. Visitors are further forbidden to:

- a)** express, spread or publicly demonstrate any racial, defamatory, vulgar or conflicting-with-good-manners slogans or images;
- b)** climb on or climb over any structures and facilities that are not meant for public use, such as facades, fences, walls, enclosure of the playground, barriers, lighting facilities, camera stands, trees, columns of any kind and roofs;
- c)** enter any areas where visitors are not allowed (e.g. the playground, interiors, rooms for football officials);
- d)** throw any items or liquids of any kind on the playground or to visitor's areas;
- e)** set fire, light or launch any fireworks or signal rockets;
- f)** destroy any equipment and facilities belonging to the FC Slovan Liberec;
- g)** FC Slovan Liberec, sell entrance tickets or any goods promoting the FC Slovan Liberec's brand without permission;
- h)** write on, stick with posters or make pictures on any structures, equipment or roads;
- i)** make any necessary corporeal needs outside toilets or make the FC Slovan Liberec premises dirty in any other way, especially by throwing away things; or
- j)** drive on the roads and areas without a special permission;
- k)** make any voice or picture recording by means of modern technologies in any way inside the FC Slovan Liberec premises or during any event;
- l)** cover any promotional panels placed on the stadium by banners, flags or in any other way.

3. The FC Slovan Liberec is entitled to seek from anyone who has breached the above mentioned prohibitions and restrictions a compensation of the damage that was caused as a result of such act; to ask for the handing over of a thing by which such damage was caused or such defective status was brought about; and further, to seek payment of a penalty amounting to CZK 1,000 at minimum and CZK 50,000 at maximum, depending on the gravity of the breach of the stipulated duties and of any damage consequences caused in relation thereto. The FC Slovan Liberec is also

entitled to ban anyone who has breached any principles of this Code of Conduct for Visitors or the above mentioned prohibitions or restrictions from entering the FC Slovan Liberec premises for a definite period of time or, depending on the gravity of such breach, also for an indefinite period of time.

§7

Sale and Advertisement

Any undertaking, handing out or selling newspapers, magazines, printed materials, promotional leaflets as well as storage of any items inside the FC Slovan Liberec premises is permitted only with an express written consent of the FC Slovan Liberec.

§8

Rights of the Organiser - Supervision

An FC Slovan Liberec authorized representative has the right to hold the post of the organiser. The same right will also apply to any organising and security personnel as well as the police during any events held there.

§9

Liability for Damage

1. Each visitor enters and uses the FC Slovan Liberec premises at his/her own risk. The FC Slovan Liberec is only liable for any damage to health and material damage caused by wilful or grossly negligent behaviour of its employees or of any persons performing their duties in a similar employment relationship.
2. Any injuries and damage have to be reported to the FC Slovan Liberec without undue delay.

§10

Acting contrary to Regulations

1. Any persons who breach the Code of Conduct for Visitors may be escorted out of the FC Slovan Liberec premises without any compensation and punished by a ban on entering the FC Slovan Liberec premises. The same will apply to any persons who are apparently under influence of alcohol or any other substances forming habit. If a visitor has a suspicion that a criminal act or another trespass has happened, he/she may lodge a complaint to the police.
2. The provisions under Paragraph 1 exclude any claims (e.g. refund of an entry fee) against the FC Slovan Liberec or an organiser of the given event.
3. Rights of the organiser remain unaffected.

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Effect

This Code of Conduct for Visitors to the FC Slovan Liberec is effective from the competition year 2011/2012.
